Agenda Items:

1. Player Suspensions

- Devin Samoratunga [#11 of the Steamers] has been suspended for the rest of this year and all of next season as the result of throwing punches
- Rob Campre [Sting] had an incident with a player from the Tigers, and then with league president Andrew Wolff
- Andrew Wolff suspended Rob Campre, as a result of a verbal exchange on the sidelines at the fields, last week
- Chris Durham spoke to the executive and shared a written submission, from Rob Campre, with those in attendance
- after considerable discussion, it was decided that the suspension levied on Rob Campre should remain in place for the remainder of the year, including playoffs
- the executive held a vote (Jason McLean excused himself from the discussion and Andrew Wolff removed himself from the vote) and the decision to uphold Andrew's suspension on Rob Campre was passed by a vote of 3 to 1, with one abstention
