

EGHA VOLUNTEER COMMITMENT FEE

Like many organizations, EGHA's success depends on the volunteer efforts of its members. Parents and friends contribute their countless hours and valuable experience supporting our club and their children by volunteering to serve as: Coaches, Team Managers, Evaluators, Board members, Oilers 50/50 workers, Casino workers, and general volunteers.

The EGHA Board of Executives passed a motion to obtain a Volunteer Commitment Fee from all families registering for hockey during the 2009/2010 season.

In order to encourage volunteerism among all members, every EGHA family will be required to post a \$100 Volunteer Commitment Cheque dated January 1, 2012. Each family will be required to perform a minimum 4 hours of their time volunteering at an EGHA event or activity before the end of the 2011-2012 season.

As an alternative to volunteering, a family may choose to make a non-refundable \$100 payment at registration.

Volunteer deposit cheques will be held by EGHA pending completion of your 4 hour volunteer commitment and will be shredded (or returned void if requested) after your commitment is fulfilled.

If you are unable to complete your scheduled 4 hour volunteer commitment before the end of the 2011-2012 season, your \$100 volunteer cheque will be cashed. *Payment if partial volunteer hours completed is not accepted, the entire \$100.00 cheque will be cashed for any family not fulfilling the entire 4 hours.*

Volunteer sheets are part of the EGHA registration package and families will be contacted as events near in order to confirm assignments. For those who registered online your Volunteer Commitment cheque must be mailed in with the required registration documentation and fee payment before your registration is considered complete. Alternatively you contact the Volunteer Coordinator directly to volunteer for EGHA events.

Thanks in advance to all of our volunteer members for their valuable time and effort. No doubt EGHA will be strengthened by the enhanced participation of our members. We look forward to a successful and fun season!

Q & A for Volunteer Commitments

Parents Questions	Answers
I have two children playing hockey do I need to supply 2 Volunteer Commitment cheques?	No, only 1 cheque / 4 minimum hour commitment per family is required.
Do I have to volunteer to take the first commitment offered to my family?	No, your name will be put back on the commitment list and you will get another opportunity.
I don't want my cheque shredded. I want my post dated cheque mailed back after my volunteering is complete?	If requested, cheque will be marked void and mailed back to address on cheque.
Where do I send my Volunteer Commitment cheque if I paid online?	Cheques must be mailed in with the required registration documentation and fee payment before your registration is considered complete. Mail to: EGHA Registrar PO Box 53510 Ellerslie RPO Edmonton, AB. T6X 0P6
Which Team Positions are included?	Coaches, Manager, Treasurer, Bench Mom and Jersey Parents
I have no time to volunteer. Can I pay the fee rather than volunteering?	A family may choose to make a non-refundable \$100 payment at registration.
Whose cheques will be cashed?	Those families who did not complete their 4 volunteer hours will have their cheques cashed on March 31, 2012. *Note: Partial commitment is not an option. Meaning even if 2 hours are completed, the entire \$100.00 cheque will still be cashed.*
Who is going to supply the Volunteer Coordinator with the dates and times	List comes from Registrar and is compiled based on the volunteer forms completed as part of the registration package.
