**Criteria for Determination of Zone 9 Representative**  
**Hockey Alberta Provincials 2012**

The criteria to determine which Calgary team will qualify to represent Calgary (Zone 9) at the Atom, Pee Wee, Bantam, and Midget Provincials are as follows:

**All Divisions**

1. The top Zone 9 team for each division will represent Zone 9 at their respective Provincials tournament. Standings for the entire season from games between only the Zone 9 teams will be used. This includes RMFHL and EMHW games versus Zone 9 opponents with an equal number\* of games played between all Zone 9 teams being considered.

\* Where a differing number of games is played between the various Zone 9 teams (including RMFHL and EMHW), the lowest common number of games will be used, with any games needing to be "dropped" being those earliest in the schedule.

2. At the end of regular season play, if two (2) or more teams are tied in points, the tie will be broken based on Hockey Calgary's Community Rule 22(d) as applied to the games played between Zone 9 teams.
3. GHC will post standings on its website to reflect the game results between the Calgary teams in order that coaches, parents and players can easily refer to the standings for Provincial qualification.

**Notes:**

Tier 1 plays Division A Provincials and Tier 2 plays Division B Provincials.

Should Calgary receive the opportunity to send a wildcard team from any division to its respective Provincials tournament, the team that is in second place (as determined in points 1 and 2 above) at the end of the season shall be named the wildcard team.

In regard to hosting Provincials for the division that is awarded to Calgary, two teams from that division will participate in the Provincial tournament. The Calgary team in first place (as determined above) at the end of season will be the Zone 9 representative. The "host" team will be the team in second place at end of the season.
