“Collection of Personal Information Notice”

Section 33 of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIP Act)

The information collected with the registration form as part of the Wembley Minor Hockey Association is personal information as referred to in the FOIP Act. This personal information is collected in conjunction with WMHA registration as the collection is related directly to and is necessary to the WMHA's obligation to provide the players with a hockey program that meets with the needs and to provide a safe and secure environment. Personal information will also be provided to the Hockey Canada and Alberta Hockey Association for the purpose of carding, setting up programs, or policies under the administration.

Once the information is collected and compiled, the WMHA believes the uses listed below are part of a healthy and functioning hockey program and participation of all players is important and encouraged. Here are examples of where your information may be used:

- The taking of team/individual photos to be placed in local and provincial newspapers or hockey related web pages.
- Using individual/team names to report statistics of games in local, provincial newspapers as well as on the Alberta Hockey Association Web page, All Peace League Web page, Trumpeter League Web Page or other Associations with hockey statistics.
- The taking of photos/videos to be used within WMHA
- The use of players names in application to hockey scholarship or other hockey related awards.
